

FALL SAMPLER QUILT - FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS


Finished quilt size: 58 ½" x 68 ½"

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Instructions

- Read all instructions before you begin
- Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows
- WOF means width of fabric (yardage is based on 42" - wide fabric)

Cutting Instructions

Description	Yardage	Quantity / Size
 Sashing & Borders Print	1 ½ yards	A (18) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles B (9) 2 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles C D } (13) 2 ½" x WOF strips

Batting		(1) 65" x 76" piece
Backing print	3 ¾ yards	(2) 65" x WOF pieces
Binding	⅔ yard	(7) 2 ¼" x WOF strips

Quilt Assembly

Step 1: Assemble the Mushroom blocks, Pumpkin blocks, Acorn blocks and Fabric A rectangles into three rows as shown. Rows should measure 6 ½" x 58 ½".

Step 2: Assemble the Rain Boot blocks, Maple Leaf blocks, Puppy blocks and Fabric B rectangles into three rows as shown. Rows should measure 12 ½" x 58 ½".

Step 3: Sew Fabric C and Fabric D strips end to end. Subcut (7) 2 ½" x 58 ½" strips (C) and (2) 2 ½" x 68 ½" (D) strips. Assemble the rows and Fabric C strips as shown.

Step 4: Sew one Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top center.

The finished Quilt Top should measure 58 ½" x 68 ½".

Finishing

Sew together the backing pieces. Make a quilt sandwich with your quilt top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired.

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the quilt using your favorite binding method. Here you will find an illustrated step-by-step tutorial on how to finish a quilt:
