### **MATERIALS AND CUTTING**

	6" x 14"	(2) 2 ½" x 5 ½"	Α
		<b>(1)</b> 2 ½" × 12 ½"	В
	9" x 15"	<b>(1)</b> 2 ½" × 12 ½"	С
		<b>(2)</b> 2 ½" x 13 ½"	D
Pillow Backing	1 FQ	(2) 11 ½" × 16 ½"	Е
Backing Fabric	1 FQ	18" x 18"	
Batting		18" x 18"	
Binding	1/4 yard	<b>(2)</b> 2 1/4" × WOF	

## **INSTRUCTIONS**


Finished pillow size: 16 1/2" x 16 1/2"


Follow the steps below to assemble the pillow. Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.

Make one 12" SANTA CLAUS quilt block.






Pillow Top should measure 16 ½" x 16 ½"

### **PILLOW ASSEMBLY**

Make a quilt sandwich with your pillow top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and fabric.

To create a hem, place a Fabric E rectangle wrong side up, fold over the long edge  $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice and press. Stitch in place. Repeat and make two. Pillow Backing should measure 11  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Align the backing pieces, right sides up and raw edges aligned, against the back of the Pillow Top. The hemmed edges should overlap 4 ½". Pin the backing in place and machine baste ½" from the edge.



# **FINISHING**

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the pillow using your favorite binding method.
