## MATERIALS AND CUTTING

	$\frac{2}{3}$ yard	(12) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "	1
		(2) $2$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ "	2
		(2) $2$ " x $21\frac{1}{2}$ "	3
		(2) $2$ " x $33\frac{1}{2}$ "	4
		(2) $2$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ "	5
Backing Fabric	$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	$40$ " x $40$ "	
Batting	$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	$40$ " x $40$ "	
Binding		(4) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF	

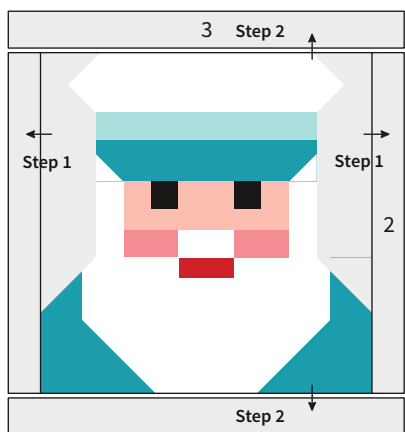
## INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the steps below to assemble the pillow. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.

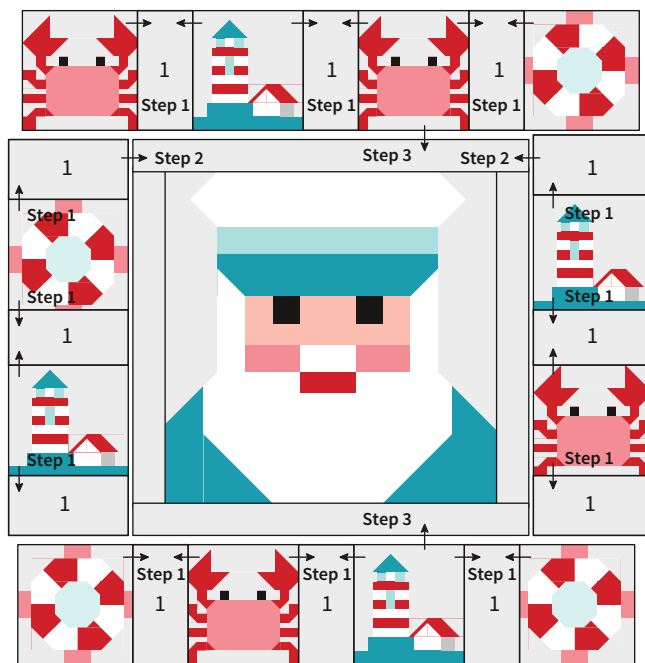
Make one 18" CAPTAIN quilt block and each four 6" CRAB, LIFESAVER, and LIGHTHOUSE quilt blocks.

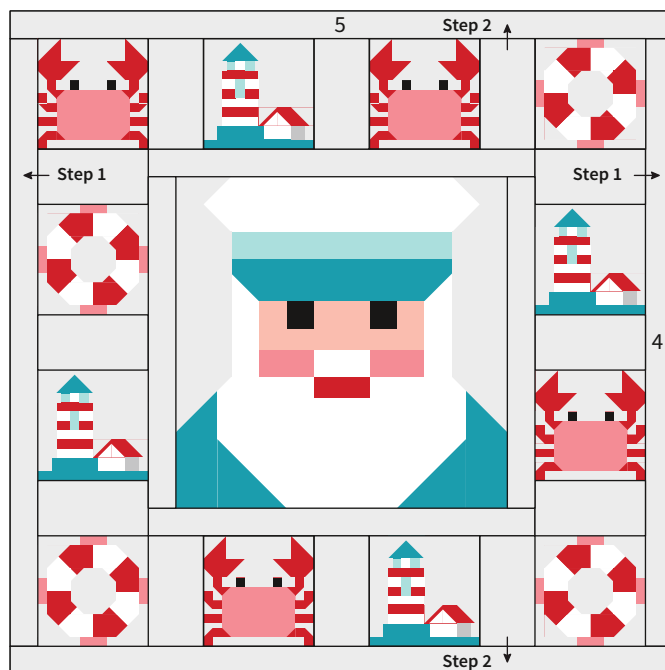

## FINISHING

Make a quilt sandwich with your quilt top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the quilt using your favorite binding method.
