

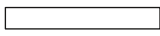


DRACULA

PILLOW TUTORIAL

MATERIALS AND CUTTING

	5" x 5"	(1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"	1
	9" x 16"	(2) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	2
		(2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	3
	9" x 10"	(1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2"	4
		(2) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"	5
Pillow Backing	1/2 yard	(2) 11 1/2" x 16 1/2"	6
Backing Fabric	1 FQ	18" x 18"	
Batting		18" x 18"	
Binding	1/4 yard	(2) 2 1/4" x WOF	

INSTRUCTIONS

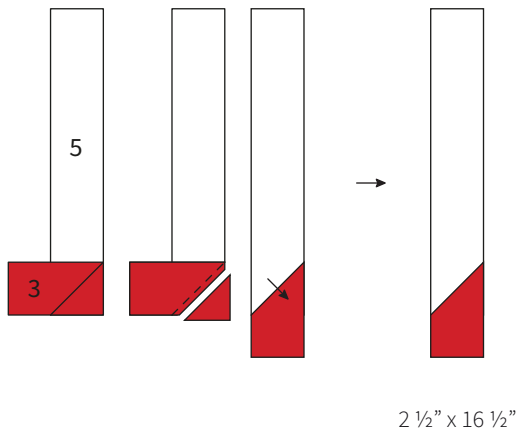
Follow the steps below to assemble the pillow. Use a 1/4" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.

Make one 12" DRACULA quilt block.

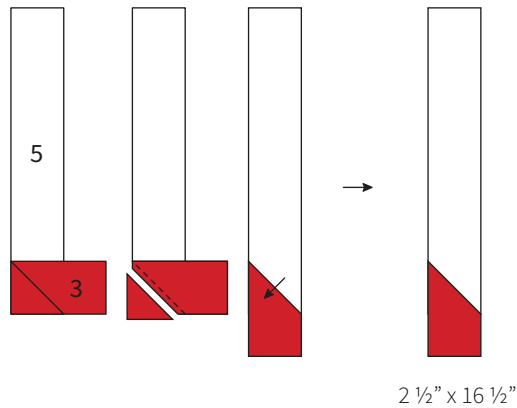

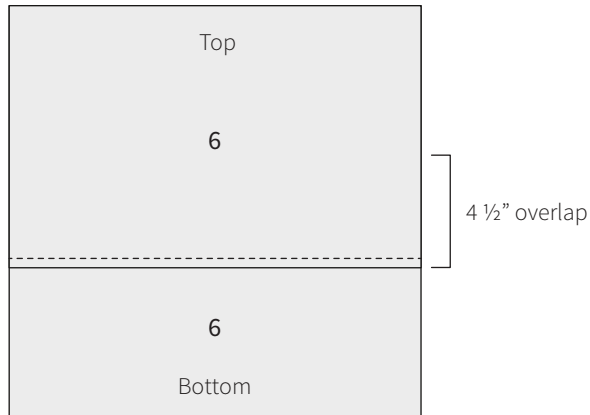
PILLOW TUTORIAL

PILLOW ASSEMBLY

Make a quilt sandwich with your pillow top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and fabric.

To create a hem, place a Fabric E rectangle wrong side up, fold over the long edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice and press. Stitch in place. Repeat and make two. Pillow Backing should measure $11\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Align the backing pieces, right sides up and raw edges aligned, against the back of the Pillow Top. The hemmed edges should overlap $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Pin the backing in place and machine baste $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the edge.



FINISHING

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the pillow using your favorite binding method. The finished pillow measures $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ".
