MATERIALS AND CUTTING


	5" x 5"	(1) 2 ½" x 8 ½"	1
	9" x 16"	(2) 2 ½" x 2 ½"	2
		(2) 2 ½"x 4 ½"	3
	9" x 10"	(1) 2 ½" x 12 ½"	4
		(2) 2 ½" x 14 ½"	5
Pillow Backing	½ yard	(2) 11 ½" × 16 ½"	6
Backing Fabric	1 FQ	18" x 18"	
Batting		18" x 18"	
Binding	1/4 yard	(2) 2 1/4" x WOF	

INSTRUCTIONS


Follow the steps below to assemble the pillow. Use a ¼" seam allowance and press the seams as shown by arrows.


Make one 12" DRACULA quilt block.







2 ½" x 16 ½"











Pillow Top should measure 16 ½" x 16 ½"




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PILLOW ASSEMBLY

Make a quilt sandwich with your pillow top, batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and fabric.

To create a hem, place a Fabric E rectangle wrong side up, fold over the long edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " twice and press. Stitch in place. Repeat and make two. Pillow Backing should measure $11\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Align the backing pieces, right sides up and raw edges aligned, against the back of the Pillow Top. The hemmed edges should overlap 4 ½". Pin the backing in place and machine baste ½" from the edge.



FINISHING

Piece the binding strips end to end and bind the pillow using your favorite binding method. The finished pillow measures 16 ½" x 16 ½"
